## 2009 PLAYER of the YEAR Details

- Player of the Year is no longer solely voted on by the Referees, but also by the opposition team. The system worked extremely well last year (for the most part) and not too much will change for this year. All who attended the awards night had a great time.
- Each Senior Team (Elite Men, Elite Women, Senior Men, Senior Women, Over 30s & Over 40s) is to appoint a person / player / manager / spectator submit a Player of the Year vote on a weekly basis, and someone to cover them if they are unavailable.
- By **Midday Tuesday** of each week that person is to logon to the Player of the Year Voting system on the QCSA Website (there is a link under Competitions > Awards) and submit a 3-2-1 vote for 3 players of the opposition team (by jersey number). 3 being the best & fairest, then 2, etc.
- They will also need to submit a 3-2-1 vote for their own team (also by jersey number).
- Any teams that have not voted by **Midday Tuesday** will be reminded to do so by the QCSA Administrator. They will then have until **Midday Wednesday** to submit their vote. If no vote is received by that time, it will **NOT** be accepted.
- If your opposition does not submit a vote, then the points given to your own team will count (if they do, they are disregarded). The opposition will also not receive the points that you awarded them.
- The Awards Dinner will be held at a time and place to be advised.
- 2 or 3 players from each Senior Team will be specifically invited to attend with an RSVP date. After that tickets will be made available to any who wish to attend. Clubs with multiple Senior Teams will be able to book tables.
- Any players suspended through send-offs or point accumulation lose 3 points off their total for every week they are suspended.
- Remember, a system like this only works properly if everyone gets involved and does the right thing.
